Brush Restorer

For hard brushes

A blend of powerful solvents that will soften hard brushes and rollers. Pour into a glass or metal container so that the roller or bristles of brush are covered. As it may take some time for the paint to soften, cover container with cling film or foil to prevent loss of restorer by evaporation. As brush softens press up and down in container so that restorer can penetrate faster. When bristles are softened, wash the brush in water to remove the paint. If brushes are splayed, wrap in cloth or paper whilst wet to restore correct shape. Do not use on perspex, lino, rubber and plastic.

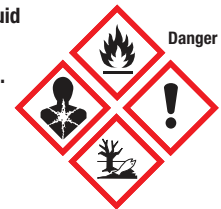
