<b>Product</b>	<b>Finish Reviver</b>
<b>Type</b>	A mixture of fine abrasives dispersed in special water based lubricating medium.
<b>Intended Use</b>	Ideal for use on antique and old furniture where the original finish has lost its lustre or has fine scratches. Finish reviver will restore the gloss and remove all minor surface defects. This product will also remove water and heat marks unless they have penetrated through to the wood. If this has happened the only remedy is to remove the old finish completely with <b>Strypit Paint &amp; Varnish Stripper</b> and re-finish. Not suitable for use on waxed surfaces.
<b>Special Features</b>	Will not destroy attractive patina that has been acquired due to age.
<b>Preparation</b>	N/A
<b>Application</b>	Apply with heavy pressure to the surface, using a pure cotton cloth or soft pad. Apply more reviver until all surface marks have been removed and finish by rubbing with a clean cloth or duster. On open grained wood a fine deposit may be left in the grain after the Finish Reviver has dried. This can be removed by brushing the grain with a nail brush and water and drying with a clean cloth.

<b>Application Temp.</b>	Ideally 10-25°C.
