

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE

Rustins Pure Tung Oil is a pure natural non-toxic oil derived from nuts grown in China and is also known as Chinese Wood Oil. It is completely free of solvent. It has good penetration into all types of timber without leaving a film and its special properties make it highly resistant to water, alcohol and food stuffs. It is additive free and safe for use in contact with food. It forms a hard wearing finish making it suitable for kitchen work surfaces, chopping boards and interior wood work but should not be used on floors.

Preparation

The surface must be clean, bare, sanded smooth and free of all traces of wax. Rustins Pure Tung Oil will bring out the natural colour of wood. If required, change the colour of the wood with Rustins Wood Dye. Always test a small area to assess the colour of the oil. If natural open-grain wood is not required then use Rustins Grain Filler before oiling.

Application

Using a clean soft cloth or brush apply liberally and allow the oil to penetrate for 20 minutes. Wipe off the excess with a clean soft cloth. The first coat of Rustins Pure Tung Oil can be diluted with 40% white spirit which will assist penetration into the timber. Do not dilute subsequent coats. New or bare wood should be oiled 3 times initially but more coats can be applied for extra protection. Allow the oiled surface to cure for a few days before use. Do not apply at temperatures below 10°C or in conditions of high humidity.

Re-Coating Time

Under warm, dry conditions the product should be allowed to dry for 24 hours before further coats are applied.

Maintenance

Re-apply annually to keep surfaces in good condition. When applying to previously oiled wood, first clean the surface and remove any wax with white spirit or Rustins Surface Cleaner. When applying to a previously coated surface, first carry out a small test for compatibility.

Coverage

1 litre covers approximately 13 square metres per coat depending on the absorbency of the wood.

Cleaning

Remove as much product as possible from brushes before cleaning. Clean brushes whilst wet with white spirit. Hard brushes can be cleaned with Rustins Brush Restorer.

Important

Rags used for oiling must be laid out flat to dry or destroyed, otherwise they may catch fire due to spontaneous combustion.

Disposal (pollution prevention)

Some local authorities have special facilities for disposal of waste paints/varnishes/coatings. Do not empty product into drains or watercourses.

Storage

Store in a cool dry place with lid tightly closed. Protect from frost.

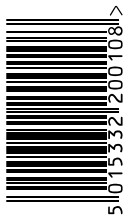
