PRODUCT DATA SHEET

Product	Sheradale Fine Antique Furniture Wax – Clear and Antique Brown
Type	A traditional formulation using a range of waxes including refined Natural Beeswax.
Intended Use	For use as a final finish on old and new wood to obtain a deep finish. Particularly suitable for cherished and antique furniture.
Special Features	Provides a deep rich sheen while retaining the natural patina of the wood. Water resistant.
Preparation	The surface must be clean and dry. Sheradale Wax can be used on previously waxed surfaces but for best results initially clean the surface with Briwax Wax Polish Remover .
Application	Apply to the surface with a soft lint free cloth working with the grain. Once dry, buff with lint free cotton cloth to achieve the desired finish.
Coats	One coat is usually sufficient but a second coat may be applied to obtain a higher sheen.
Drying Time	Quick Drying
Re-coating Time	Re-apply if required after a few minutes
Application Temp.	Ideally 15-25° C
Coverage	N/A
Maintenance	Re-apply when necessary.
Compatibility	Compatible with all types of timber finishes. For best results and to prevent a blotchy appearance timber should always be previously sealed with a varnish, oil or Briwax Shellac Sanding Sealer .
Settlement	N/A
Shelf-life/Storage	A very long time if stored in original container tightly sealed in a cool dry place.
Hazards	Highly Flammable. May cause sensitisation by skin contact. Repeated exposure may cause skin dryness and cracking. Harmful to the environment. Keep out of reach of children. Clean-Up	Hands and application cloth can be cleaned in warm soapy water.
