Product	Wax Removing Solution
Type	A special blend of mild and strong solvents formulated to remove wax finishes from a wide variety of timber
Intended Use	For use on raw or sealed wax timber.
Special Features	Ease of use. Helps restore original surface detail.
Preparation	N/A
Application	Apply onto a clean dry soft cloth and work into the surface in the direction of the grain, removing soil as it is generated. Wipe off any excess liquid and loose wax with a clean dry soft cloth and allow to dry.
Coats	Apply process as required until all wax has been removed.
Drying Time	Quick drying
Re-coating Time	As soon as previous application has flashed off
Application Temp.	Ideally 15 - 25°C.
Coverage	N/A
Maintenance	Re-apply as necessary.
Compatibility	Unsuitable for use on French polished, shellac coated or lacquered surfaces. More traditional furniture finishes should have any wax removed by using Briwax Furniture Reviver/Restorer . If a non-wax finish is to follow, check compatibility/complete wax removal.
Settlement	N/A
Shelf-life/Storage	A very long time if stored in original sealed container in a cool dry place.
Hazards	Highly flammable. Irritating to eyes. Vapours may cause drowsiness. Keep away from children. Keep away from all sources of ignition. No smoking. A full Health & Safety Data Sheet is available on request or from www.antiquax.co.uk
Clean-Up	Hands and application cloths can be cleaned in warm soapy water
