## PRODUCT DATA SHEET

<b>Product</b>	<b>Natural Wood Wax</b>
<b>Type</b>	A clear wax treatment using natural plant oils, hard vegetable waxes and essential oils to protect all types of solid woodwork
<b>Intended Use</b>	For protection of interior woodwork against regular use. Ideal for use on kitchen worktops, food preparation areas and chopping boards.
<b>Special Features</b>	Free from mineral solvents and synthetic raw materials. Made from 100% natural renewable ingredients. Naturally helps eliminate food odours. Does not go rancid. Minimal colour. Provides an easy to clean surface.
<b>Preparation</b>	Untreated woodwork must be clean and dry prior to use
<b>Application</b>	For best results chopping board should be conditioned with Briwax Natural Oil prior to waxing. Apply a light coat using a clean lint-free cloth and allow to dry.
<b>Coats</b>	Normally a single application is sufficient
<b>Drying Time</b>	Quick drying.
<b>Re-coating Time</b>	Not applicable
<b>Application Temp.</b>	Ideally between 15-25 deg. C. Do not apply below 10 deg. C
<b>Coverage</b>	Approx. 12-14 sq. metres per litre depending on the absorbancy of the wood
<b>Maintenance</b>	Periodic re-oiling and waxing is required. Clean surface before refinishing using warm water and mild detergent
<b>Compatibility</b>	Compatible with all types of wood including bamboo
<b>Settlement</b>	Not applicable
<b>Shelf-life/Storage</b>	Many years if stored in original, tightly closed container in a cool, dry, dark place
<b>Hazards</b>	Keep out of reach of children. In case of eye contact copiously wash eyes immediately with water and seek medical advice. After skin contact wash immediately with soap and water.
