## PRODUCT DATA SHEET

<b>Product</b>	Quick Dry Hard Wax Oil
<b>Type</b>	Water based and quick drying. A blend of castor oil, that dries to a hard, durable transparent finish, resistant to stains, alcohol and water.
<b>Intended Use</b>	Bare wood, hardboard, MDF, unsealed cork, concrete, stone, unsealed quarry and terracotta tiles. <b>Interior use only.</b>
<b>Special Features</b>	Low odour. Non-yellowing on ageing. Quick-drying. Wash brushes in water. Generally, has very little effect on the colour of the timber it is applied to.
<b>Preparation</b>	The surface must be clean, smooth, dry and free from wax, dust and contaminants. Read the full instructions on the tin. Nail holes and small cracks may be filled with <b>Rustins Wood Fillers</b> . Bare wood may be dyed before coating with <b>Briwax Wood Dye</b> . Other brands of dye, stain or paints may be incompatible. Do not apply Knotting or Sanding Sealer.
<b>Application</b>	Using a lint free cloth, synthetic brush or varnish roller, apply evenly and liberally, finishing in the direction of the grain and wipe of the excess.
<b>Coats</b>	Apply 3 coats according to the coverage rate. More absorbent surfaces or commercial premises may require 4 coats. <b>Important:</b> If there is any grain raising after the 1st coat has dried, lightly sand the surface smooth before applying the next coat.
<b>Drying Time</b>	Typically 2 hours for oil to be completely absorbed
<b>Application Temp.</b>	Ideally between 15-25 deg. C. Do not apply below 10 deg. C
<b>Coverage</b>	Approx. 20-30 sq. metres per litre depending on the absorbency of the wood
<b>Maintenance</b>	Periodic re-oiling is required. Clean surface before refinishing using warm water and mild detergent
<b>Settlement</b>	Shake well before use.
<b>Shelf-life/Storage</b>	Many years if stored in original, tightly closed container in a cool, dry, dark place
<b>Hazards</b>	Keep out of reach of children. In case of eye contact copiously wash eyes immediately with water and seek medical advice. After skin contact wash immediately with soap and water. <b>Clean-Up</b>	Clean up with warm water and detergent
<b>Sizes</b>	1 litre, 2.5 litre
