## PRODUCT DATA SHEET

<b>Product</b>	<b>Stove Glass Cleaner Spray</b>
<b>Type</b>	Liquid.
<b>Intended Use</b>	Formulated to quickly and easily dissolve tar/creosote deposits and smoke stains. Use <b>Hotspot Stove Glass Cleaner</b> on wood, coal or oil burning equipment, glass firescreens or fronts.
<b>Special Features</b>	Trigger spray. Tough action cleaner.
<b>Preparation</b>	Ensure the surface to be cleaned is cool, shake gently before use. Protect carpets or non-wipe clean surfaces from any product run off.
<b>Application</b>	Spray lightly to completely cover stained area. Leave for up to 2 minutes. Wipe off with a cloth and polish glass. If stubborn stains remain, repeat using a nylon scouring pad.
<b>Coats</b>	Use regularly to avoid substantial accumulations of tar/creosote.
<b>Drying Time</b>	2 minutes.
<b>Re-coating Time</b>	N/A
<b>Application Temp.</b>	Cool.
<b>Coverage</b>	N/A
<b>Maintenance</b>	On woodburning stoves use regularly to avoid substantial accumulations of tar/creosote deposits on glass doors
<b>Compatibility</b>	Use on wood, coal or oil burning equipment, glass fire screens or fronts. Can also be used on glass oven doors to remove grease.
<b>Settlement</b>	N/A
<b>Shelf-life/Storage</b>	Store in a cool, dry place.
<b>Hazards</b>	Causes serious eye irritation. May cause drowsiness or dizziness.
