## PRODUCT DATA SHEET

<b>Product</b>	<b>Fireplace Cleaner</b>
<b>Type</b>	Liquid.
<b>Intended Use</b>	For removing smoke, soot and tar stains caused by wood, coal and gas fires, from brick, stone, concrete, marble and other hard surfaces.
<b>Special Features</b>	Brisk brushing creates foam, which cleans smoke stains, right down to the pores, without damage. Eliminates the need for harsh, damaging acids.
<b>Preparation</b>	Ensure surface to be cleaned is cool, remove screens, fixtures etc. and protect floors and carpets. <b>Wear protective gloves and clothing.</b> Wet the area to be cleaned with water.
<b>Application</b>	Pour Fireplace Cleaner onto a cloth and apply to the surface to be cleaned. Leave for approximately 1 minute and then rub vigorously with a damp cloth. Rough-textured or pock-marked surfaces will require brushing – an old nail or toothbrush is ideal.
<b>Coats</b>	As required.
<b>Drying Time</b>	Leave for 1 minute.
<b>Re-coating Time</b>	If stubborn stains remind, repeat treatment.
<b>Application Temp.</b>	15 – 25 degrees Centigrade..
<b>Coverage</b>	10 – 20 sq. metres per litre depending on the condition of the surface to be cleaned.
<b>Maintenance</b>	Use as required.
<b>Compatibility</b>	Do not use on any decorated or painted slate or stone. It does not normally remove discolouration caused by weathering or natural impurities.
<b>Settlement</b>	Shake well before use.
<b>Shelf-life/Storage</b>	2 years if stored unopened in a cool, dry place.
<b>Hazards</b>	Corrosive; causes burns. Keep out of reach of children. For full product safety data visit <a href="http://www.rustinsltd/hotspot">www.rustinsltd/hotspot</a> and download SDS.
<b>Clean-Up</b>	Rinse area thoroughly with water and remove surface water with absorbent cloth.
<b>Sizes</b>	500ml bottle.
