## PRODUCT DATA SHEET

<b>Product</b>	<b>Flue Free Chimney Cleaner Sachets</b>
<b>Type</b>	Granular combustion deposit conditioner in convenient sachets.
<b>Intended Use</b>	Flue Free Chimney Cleaner works by rising into the chimney carried on the flue gases. On contact, Flue Free Chimney Cleaner reacts with the acids in the tar/creosote deposits and fluidises them. Absorbents in Flue Free Chimney Cleaner then soak up these fluids, producing a shrivelling or drying action, which weakens the bonding to the chimney surface. These deposits eventually fall back down the chimney or are more easily removed by sweeping.
<b>Special Features</b>	Non-corrosive. Flue Free Chimney Cleaner will lessen the risk of chimney fires, as it works against the build-up of creosote. Stops and removes tar/creosote build-up, reduces risk of chimney corrosion and maintains clean heating surfaces for maximum efficiency.
<b>Preparation</b>	It is advisable to arrange for the chimney to be swept prior to commencing.
<b>Application</b>	For maximum effectiveness use on a low fire with tray emptied. The fireplace should be lit but almost burnt out. Carefully place the sachet in the centre of the fire. To accelerate the process, close the damper/stove door and place fireproof metal sheets across the fire opening. Let the fire burn out and dispose of the cooled ash/debris. Use 2 sachets for large fires or boilers or where chimney flue is abnormally large or dirty.
<b>Coats</b>	N/A
<b>Drying Time</b>	Allow the fire to burn out completely.
<b>Re-coating Time</b>	N/A
<b>Application Temp.</b>	The fireplace should be lit but almost burnt out.
<b>Coverage</b>	N/A
<b>Maintenance</b>	Flue Free Chimney Cleaner should be used on a regular maintenance basis. Flue Free Chimney Cleaner should reduce the frequency of chimney sweeping needed, however regular sweeping is still essential. Chimneys should be inspected once or twice a year to ensure clean and safe conditions.
<b>Compatibility</b>	Suitable for all flues, including those lined with stainless steel. Not for use on electric or gas fires
<b>Settlement</b>	Shake well before use.
<b>Shelf-life/Storage</b>	Store in a cool, dry environment.
<b>Hazards</b>	Causes skin irritation. Causes serious eye irritation. May cause respiratory irritation. Do not breathe dust or mists. Wash thoroughly after handling. IF INHALED: Remove person to fresh air and keep comfortable for breathing. Call a POISON CENTRE/doctor if you feel unwell. IF ON SKIN (or hair): Take off immediately all contaminated clothing. Rinse skin with water/shower. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse. IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing.
